That will allow players on the waiting list a chance to participate. **Refunds for withdrawals were only available until August 9th**, but it still helps to know if you cannot attend.

## What to bring:

A PEN or PENCIL for notation. NOT provided!

A chess clock (few provided. PLEASE bring your own!)

Chess set (for going over games between rounds)

Snacks/Drinks (keep it healthy, see below for more information)

We have no official concessions. The hotel offers a small coffee shop and also has a restaurant called the Onion Creek Grille, open only 7am – 1pm. Bring lunch and snacks!!! Only water in a container with lid at the chess board.

Please allow extra time on Saturday morning to find your playing space. Both scholastic sections will play in **the Oaks room** – along the front wall of the hotel, to your right after you walk in the entrance.

All phones must be turned off during the round and if brought in, may not leave the playing room during the round. No earphones.

**Pairings and Wall Charts** will be available online. We will post a paper copy of pairings before each round. You will record your results with your TD(s). Remember, no pairing is final until the round actually begins. If you are listed as having a forced bye, we still might be able to find you a game.

It is your responsibility to make sure you are on time for each game. No announcements will be made inside or out. We will be following the **posted round schedule**.

round 1 – 10:00am round 2 – 11:30am lunch break round 3 – 1:30pm round 4 – 2:45pm round 5 – 4:00pm

Trophies and medals will be handed out in the playing room as soon as the games are finished.

If you are late for round 1 and you have **not** notified us (registrar@austinchesstournaments.com AND austinchesstournaments.com ) that you are on your way, we assume you will not be attending. Your game will be reassigned and you will be withdrawn. In rounds 2 – 4, late arrival means a loss of time on your clock. It is VERY IMPORTANT that if you're done playing, you withdraw before the next round is played. Leaving without saying anything is very bad form, wastes your opponent's time, and will cost you a monetary penalty on your next tournament entry.

We need the rounds to stay on schedule. You will be paired for every round unless you request a bye or withdraw. See chess control (Melissa) for onsite byes or withdrawal requests.
